*Advance registration is required and accepted in the order received. Registration is not complete until full payment or purchase order is received. ### Description:

Friends magnify our joys and support us in our struggles, but sometimes young adults with disabilities need assistance in connecting with potential friends. That's where a facilitated social network can make all the difference to quality of life. In this workshop we'll learn about the concepts of a social network and discuss the role that a facilitator can play in helping to develop a network. We'll discuss potential funding sources for facilitation and make plans for ongoing training, support, and mentoring for families and facilitators who are interested in forming a social network for someone.
